# Padded Night Splint

# **INDICATIONS**

The padded night splint provides dorsi-flexion to aid in the treatment of plantar fasciitis, Achilles tendonitis, and general heel pain. Effective in providing a passive stretch to the Achilles tendon and plantar fascia by pushing from the bottom of the foot.

### **PREPARATION**

1. Loosen all closure straps, leaving the night splint completely open.

# **APPLICATION**

- Place foot inside the night splint, making sure the heel of the foot is flush with the heel of the splint itself. (Fig. A)
  While keeping the foot in position, wrap the distal closure strap over the top of the foot and secure using the Velcro provided. (Fig. B)
- Wrap the two ankle closure straps and secure, making sure that the heel stays aligned with the heel of the splint. (Fig. C)
- Finally, wrap the top closure around the shin and secure using the Velcro provided. Re-adjust as needed, making sure the splint fits snug and little movement is achieved.
  (Fig. D)

# **Dorsi-Flexion Adjustment**

 The padded night splint provides what is called "passive dorsi-flexion" using a foam wedge located under the foot.
Once the splint has been applied, if pain is experienced with the foot in this position, take the splint off and remove the foam wedge under the foot. Re-apply using the steps above. (Fig. E)
