Description: The MASK-it Eye Patch is designed as a translucent, single-use, adjustable, hygienic and adhesive paper patch.

Indications for Use: The paper patch is applied to and worn by an individual for the execution of a variety of specific activities related to the need for temporary monocular occlusion.

How supplied: The patches are removed individually from a box with a roll of either 250 or 500 patches perbox.

How to Use (see reverse side):

- Gently peel the patch from the backing, starting from the smaller end of the patch – notice where the adhesive is located
- Flip the patch so the adhesive is face down try to not touch the adhesive much
- Separate the paper at the partial pre-cut slit section of each patch
- Create a slight conical shape of varying depth, as needed. Notice that
 the narrower the face, or the longer the lashes, the deeper the cone,
 and the flatter the face, the shallower the cone. A shallower cone
 ensures the best adhesion there's no need to make the cone very
 deep
- Apply to the individual face by tapping on the glued smaller section between the eyebrows and the glued larger area near the cheekbone, below the eye – it is applied on an angle
- For the second eye, simply remove the patch and repeat the same procedure on the fellow eye, using the same patch
