

- Step 1. Determine the set back for the cassette roller Set back will be equal to the door thickness plus 1/4".
- Step 2. Determine the centerline of the cassette roller Locate the centerline of the cassette roller the same as the approximate centerline of the top and bottom door frame rail.
- Step 3. Secure the cassette roller with enclosed screws
