

#### **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- (1) 9/16" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) 3/4" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) 15/16" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) Level Device

- (1) Anti-seize Compound
- (1) Scaffolding, Lull or Lift
- (1) 10 or 12 FT Step Ladder (for final adjustments)


## **Important Note:**

- INSTALLATION OF THE HOOP REJUVENATOR SYSTEM REQUIRES THE LIFTING AND HANDLING OF SUBSTANTIAL WEIGHT, UP TO 270 LBS. SAFE INSTALLATION REQUIRES AT LEAST THREE MEN AND THE USE OF APPROPRIATE MATERIAL HANDLING EQUIPMENT SUCH AS SCAFFOLDING, A LULL OR LIFT.
- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ASSEMBLE THE HOOP REJUVENATOR OFF A STEP LADDER.
- THE HOOP REJUVENATOR OFFERS THE ABILITY TO ADJUST THE HEIGHT OF THE BOARD AND PLUMB IT INDEPENDENTLY. CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN AT EACH STEP TO ENSURE THE FRAMEWORK IS SQUARE AND PLUMB.
- THIS PRODUCT USES STAINLESS STEEL HARDWARE BECAUSE OF ITS SUPERIOR RESISTANCE TO RUST AND CORROSION. STAINLESS NUTS CAN SOMETIME SEIZE ONTO THE BOLT THREADS DURING INSTALLATION OR REMOVAL. TO PREVENT THE STAINLESS HARDWARE FROM SEIZING, LIBERALLY APPLY SOME ANTI-SEIZE COMPOUND TO THE BOLT THREADS, OR SPRAY THE THREADS WITH A PENETRATING LUBRICANT, SUCH AS WD-40.

### **Upright Installation:**


- 1. Check local building codes before starting the footing, as building codes may vary. Local building codes should be adhered to if requirements are greater than those outlined here.
- 2. Dig a hole 36 inches square or round to a depth on 54 inches, pour an 6 inch footing and allow fully curing or placing upright on two 6 inch concrete blocks.
- 3. Assemble the anti-rotational hardware and position and square the upright onto the footing base. Pour the remainder of the footing. Allow the concrete to fully cure, per the manufacturer's instructions (no less than 24 hrs), before attaching the H-Frame backboard and goal.

# **Upright Assembly:**

1. Attach the H-Frame gooseneck bracket together (Figure 5).

### **Frame Assembly:**

- 1. Attach the T-Frame to the H-Frame slot channel with 1/2" carriage hardware as shown (*Figure 1*). Do not tighten.
- 2. Slide the T-Frame on the H-Frame slot channel till the bottom of both frames are at a distance of 6-7/16" (*Figure 2*) and tighten the carriage bolts down.
- 3. Attach H-Frame board bracket to the inner H-Frame slot channel holes. Use 1/2" hex bolt hardware as shown (*Figure 3*). Set the distance between brackets to be 3-3/8" as shown (*Figure 4*). Do not tighten hardware.






# **Board Assembly:**

1. Attach the T-Frame to the Fan backboard with 3/8" hardware as shown (*Figure 7 & Figure 8*).





### Frame Assembly Attachment:

- 1. Lift and attach the frame assembly to the mounting plates using 5/8" hardware. Adjust and frame assembly plumb to the playing surface. Do not over tighten.
- 2. Once the H-Frame board brackets in on the H-Frame gooseneck bracket. Tighten the board bracket hardware (Figure 9).

3. Using the 4 holes in the outer plates as a template to drill thru to the other side of the plate and lock the plumb in place with 4 set of 3/8" hardware as shown (Figure 10). H-FRAME GOOSENECK BRACKETS ON THE INSIDE H-FRAME BOARD BRACKETS ON THE OUTSIDE







### **Maintenance:**

Thoroughly inspect the system at least twice a year check all hardware for tightness and wear.

Inspect the system for any surface rust. Brush off and protect rusted areas with a Rustoleum type zinc spray.

Check the height and plumpness of the system. Carefully adjust if needed.
