1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1.1 SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS This manual contains important safety and operating instructions.
- 1.2 Read, understand and follow all instructions, cautions and warnings listed in this manual. Failure to follow all instructions and abide by all cautions and warnings could result in personal injury, injury to others and property damage.
- 1.3 IMPORTANT! CHARGE WORK LIGHT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PURCHASE, AFTER EACH USE, AND AT LEAST EVERY 6 MONTHS.
- 1.4 DO NOT turn on the work light while it is being charged.
- **1.5 DO NOT** handle or move the work light while it is being charged.
- 1.6 DO NOT look directly into the light or shine the light directly into the eyes of any person or animal.
- 1.7 DO NOT allow children to use the work light.
- 1.8 DO NOT operate the work light if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped, or otherwise damaged in any way; take it to a qualified service person.
- **1.9 DO NOT** leave the battery in a discharged state.
- 1.10 DO NOT use the work light with a charger which has a damaged cord or plug, replace the cord or plug immediately.

2. PERSONAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

WARNING! TO REDUCE THE RISK OF BURNS OR FIRE, FOLLOW THESE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- 2.1 DO NOT disassemble the work light; take it to a qualified service person when service or repair is required. Incorrect reassembly may result in a risk of fire.
- **2.2 DO NOT** crush, puncture, short external contacts or dispose of in fire or water.

- **2.3 DO NOT** expose to temperatures above 140°F (60°C).
- **2.4** Recycle or dispose of the used battery as required by local regulations.
- 2.5 If the electrolyte in the cells gets on your skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If it gets into your eyes, rinse thoroughly with cool water and seek immediate medical attention.
- 2.6 This product contains a lithium ion battery. In case of fire, you may use water, a foam extinguisher, Halon, CO₂, ABC dry chemical, powdered graphite, copper powder or soda (sodium carbonate) to extinguish the fire. Once the fire is extinguished, douse the product with water, an aqueous-based extinguishing agent, or other nonalcoholic liquids to cool the product and prevent the battery from re-igniting. NEVER attempt to pick up or move a hot, smoking, or burning product, as you may be injured.
- 2.7 WARNING: This product contains one or more chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

3. SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Remove any cord wraps and uncoil the charging cable.

5. CHARGING

IMPORTANT! CHARGE THE WORK LIGHT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PURCHASE, AFTER EACH USE, AND AT LEAST EVERY 6 MONTHS. Failure to do this will reduce the battery's capacity and may void the warranty.

- 5.1 Connect the micro USB end of the charging cable to the micro USB port on the back of the work light. Insert the USB end of the cable into the USB port on your charger.
- **5.2** Plug your charger into a live power source.
- **5.3** The charging LED will light **RED**, to indicate charging has begun.
- **5.4** When the battery is fully charged, the charging LED will change to **GREEN**.
- **5.5** Recharge the work light after use, and at least every 6 months.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Hang the work light, using the hooks on the back. When hung from a single hook, the work light can be rotated 360° for more precise positioning.
- **6.2** The magnets may be used instead. Attach to any ferrous metal surface.
- **6.3** Direct the lens away from your eyes before turning on the work light.
- 6.4 Press ⊕ once to turn on the 3W end LED.
 Press ⊕ a second time to turn on the high-power SMD LEDs.
 Press ⊕ a third time to turn on the low-power SMD LEDs.
 Press ⊕ to turn off.
- **6.5** Recharge the work light after use, and at least every 6 months.

7. MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 After use and before performing maintenance, unplug and disconnect the work light.
- **7.2** Use a dry cloth to wipe any dirt or oil from the charging cable and case.
- 7.3 Ensure that all of the work light's components are in place and in good working condition.
- **7.4** Servicing does not require opening the unit, as there are no user-serviceable parts.
- **7.5** Any servicing should be performed by qualified service personnel.

8. STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

- **8.1** Store inside, in a cool, dry place.
- **8.2** Take care to avoid/prevent damage to the charging cable and unit. Failure to do so could result in personal injury or property damage.
- **8.3** Charge the work light's internal battery immediately after purchase, after every use and every 6 months.
- 8.4 All batteries are affected by temperature. The ideal storage temperature is at 70°F (21°C). The internal battery will gradually self-discharge (lose power) over time, especially in warm environments. Leaving the battery in a discharged state may result in permanent battery damage. To ensure satisfactory performance and avoid permanent damage, charge the internal battery every 6 months.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING
